


TASK FORCE STRUCTURE





NEXT STEPS FOR TASK FORCE REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION AND FINAL REPORT

October 2014: Draft Task Force report regarding phase I of implementation

December 2014: Task Force meeting to finalize recommendations and report

February 2015: Chair presents final Task Force report and Children's Commission votes on recommendations

January-June 2015: Staff formulate structure and prepare for phase II of implementation

July 2015-December 2016
Phase II Implementation may include post-secondary focus; a standing Education Committee of the Children's Commission
