To contain the spread of COVID-19, all previously ordered parent-child visitations, sibling visitations, ad litem visitations, and DFPS visits that were to be conducted in-person are HEREBY ORDERED SUSPENDED.


All ad litem and DFPS caseworkers are ORDERED to conduct their visits telephonically or via videoconference.

Furthermore, DFPS is ORDERED to make arrangements for conducting parent-child and sibling visits via telephone or videoconference.

This Emergency Order shall also apply to all children in relative or fictive kin placements.

This Emergency Order takes effect on the date of signing and expires on April 3, 2020 unless extended by further order.
