TEMPORARY ORDER SUSPENDING IN-PERSON VISITATION IN CHAPTER 262 CASES (CPS)

Comes now the undersigned Judges, and after careful consideration and with further guidance being given by the Supreme Court of the State of Texas as well as the Office of Court Administration, making the following Temporary Orders:


- A. Effective immediately, and until modified by these Courts, all in-person visitation previously ordered in Chapter 262 matters (CPS) is suspended;
- B. The Department is ORDERED to facilitate reasonable electronic communication and visitation in place of in-person visitation;
- C. If any party feels aggrieved by these Temporary Orders or the Department’s efforts to provide substituted communication and visitation, that party is instructed to file a Written Objection seeking relief from this Order.

The Courts will review this Order and may make modifications as the circumstances allow.

This Order does not affect non-Chapter 262 cases where CPS is not a party.

The Courts find that this modification is in the best interest of the children affected by this Order.
