

STANDING ORDER REGARDING PARENT-CHILD VISITATION AND
OTHER FACE TO FACE VISITS IN ALL CHILD PROTECTION CASES IN
THE COUNTY COURT AT LAW OF MOORE COUNTY

1. All previously ordered parent-child visitations, sibling visitations, Attorney Ad Litem and/or Guardian Ad Litem visits, and DFPS visits scheduled to take place between March 27, 2020, and May 8, 2020, are HEREBY ORDERED SUSPENDED in an effort to contain the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) and to protect all parties.
2. THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES (DFPS), ST. FRANCIS MINISTRIES, ATTORNEY AD LITEMS and GUARDIAN AD LITEMS are HEREBY ORDERED to make arrangements for telephonic or virtual electronic visits through Skype, Facetime or other video communication in place of in-person visitation between March 27, 2020, and May 8, 2020.
3. This ORDER shall also apply to children who are in relative or fictive kin placements.
